**Key facts** 

 Ticks can cause an allergic reaction and they spread tickborne diseases.  Ticks can latch on to a passing animal or person by crawling up the stems of grasses or along branches.

Check children








How to kill ticks



Kill the tick where it is, using an ether-containing spray.



Wait for the tick to drop off. Do not forcibly remove the tick with tweezers.



**Do not remove the tick** - kill it with ether-containing spay. If you are allergic to ticks or have mammalian meat allergy seek medical help. If you or someone near you has trouble breathing or collapses after a tick bite, **call triple zero (000) and ask for an ambulance**. If you have access to an adrenaline autoinjector, administer it, and continue to follow the steps of an ASCIA allergy action plan, if one is available.
